 maintain commercial liability of \$1M per incident have a zero-tolerance policy for intoxicating substances receive timely notice of changes in driving record from CA DMV 	 conduct criminal background checks; exclude drivers with certain convictions within 7 years obtain drivers' records; exclude drivers with 3+ points or major violations see that drivers possess a valid California drivers' license, are at least 21, and submit proof of insurance 	 require 19-point vehicle inspections prior to operation and annually allow only street-legal passenger vehicles that are not significantly modified allow no more than 7 passengers require "trade dress" on vehicles
































































Better Coverage? Oversupply?
