




#### Reduce CO<sub>2</sub> 40% below 1990 levels




#### Reduce VMT per person 10% below today's levels



#### Reduce congestion 20% below today's levels




Reduce by 10% the share of income spent by lower- and moderate-income households on transportation and housing combined\*




#### **Transit**

Decrease average age of all assets to 50% of useful life



#### **Local Streets and Roads**

Decrease mileage in poor condition to no more than 13%\*
